

Promotion-Specific Conditions

GameSense Sports: Skill or Chance Contest

1) **Promotion:** Sports Betting Skill or Chance Contest (the “**Promotion**”)

This Promotion is governed by these terms and conditions (the “**Conditions**”) as well as BCLC’s General Terms and Conditions for Promotions (the “**General Conditions**”). Where the Conditions and the General Conditions conflict, these Conditions will prevail.

2) **Promotion Period:** This promotion runs from May 11, 2026 at 12:00 pm PT to July 19, 2026 at 11:59 pm PT.

3) **Prize:** There is one (1) grand prize to be won in this promotion. The winner will receive a maximum of one (1) prize in this promotion. The prize is one (1) VIP BC Lions Home Game Experience for the winner and 3 friends (approximate retail value of \$3,000 CAD). The prize package consists of:

- a) Four (4) game tickets to the BC Lions home game in Vancouver, BC on August 8, 2026;
- b) Coin toss/game ball delivery experience and behind-the-scenes player walkout;
- c) Visit to the team bench and sideline access to watch player warm-ups;
- d) Pre-Game Meet & Greet with Alumni one hour pre-game for dinner/appetizers.

4) **Qualified Entrant:** In addition to the requirements for a Qualified Entrant in the General Conditions, for this promotion the entrant must be a British Columbia resident 19 years of age or older who is not a:

- a) BCLC employee, consultant or contractor;
- b) BCLC “Lottery Site Employee” as defined in the BCLC Retailer Policy Manual;
- c) family or household member of (a) or (b) residing at the same address;
- d) participant in BCLC’s Game Break Program; or
- e) banned or barred from a casino or community gaming centre or by BCLC.

5) **How to Enter:** A qualified entrant must complete the below steps during the Contest Period:

- a) complete the Skill or Chance quiz at <https://gamesense.com/articles/stay-in-command-of-your-game.html>
- b) click the ‘Enter Contest’ button at the end of the quiz (the “Entry Form”)

- a) complete and submit the Entry Form to gain one entry.
- 6) **Number of Entries:** A Qualified Entrant may receive a maximum of one (1) qualified entry in this Promotion. (each an “**Entry**”). Entries must be received by BCLC before the end of the Promotion Period.
- 7) **Draw(s):** The draw to select one (1) Qualified Entrant will be conducted by July 24, 2026 or as soon as practicable thereafter. The Drawn Entrant will be deemed a Winner when BCLC confirms the Drawn Entrant meets these contest conditions.
- 8) **Odds:** Odds of winning depend on the number of Entries received during the Promotion Period.
- 9) **No Purchase Necessary:** No purchase is necessary to enter this Promotion.
- 10) **Conditions of Prize:**
 - a) The Prize must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable, assignable, or substitutable, except at BCLC’s sole discretion.
 - b) Travel and Guests: The winner and their guests are responsible for any costs not explicitly listed (e.g., meals outside the suite, incidentals, travel insurance).
- 11) **Time to Claim Prize:** Drawn Entrants must accept a prize within forty-eight (48) hours of initial contact by BCLC or its service providers.
- 12) **How to Claim a Prize:** To claim a Prize, a Drawn Entrant must, upon request by BCLC:
 - a) confirm acceptance of the Prize by telephone and/or email;
 - b) provide valid government-issued photo identification;
 - c) correctly answer a time-limited skill-testing question;
 - d) execute and return any required declarations, releases, waivers, and indemnities;
 - e) Coordination with BC Lions: A representative from the BC Lions will contact the winner using the contact information provided to BCLC to coordinate the logistics of the VIP BC Lions game-day experience.

A Drawn Entrant must confirm acceptance of the Prize and satisfy all eligibility and prize-claim requirements within forty-eight (48) hours of the first contact attempt by BCLC. If the Drawn Entrant:

- a) cannot be contacted within that time;
- b) declines or fails to accept the Prize;

- c) fails to correctly answer the skill-testing question;
- d) fails to provide required documentation; or
- e) is determined by BCLC, in its sole discretion, to be ineligible or in breach of these Conditions,

then the Drawn Entrant will be disqualified and a Reserve Drawn Entrant may be selected, in the order drawn, to replace the disqualified Drawn Entrant.

This process will continue until the Prize is awarded or until there are no remaining Reserve Drawn Entrants, in which case the Prize may, at BCLC's sole discretion, remain unawarded.

In no event shall BCLC be liable for a Drawn Entrant or Reserve Drawn Entrant not receiving notification that their name has been drawn.
